## **Work experience can add value to a young person's CV and help them move into the labour market.**

**We want to inspire young people to take control of their futures and seize the chance to demonstrate all the skills employers value.**

This programme is addressed to young people aged 16-18 and Not in Education Training or Employment (NEET)

Show proof of identification in order to enrol. The following evidence will be accepted: passport, birth certificate (EU only), driving licence (Full) (EU only). If nationality on the driving licence is outside of EU, driving licence is not acceptable and will require passport.

The programme is for a 3 to 4 months period and the participants will attend 3 days a week for:

### **Up to 6 weeks when they will receive**

- Receive employability skills training
- English and Maths classes (from week 1 to week 16)
- Tutorial support

### **Up to 10 weeks when they will attend**

- Work placement in industries such as **transport, childcare, education, retail, etc.** The placement will be in the specific industry of their choice for the period of up to 10 weeks.
